CONDITION OF RENTAL PROPERTY CHECKLIST

Every unit and each property is different. Each property checklist must be adjusted in order to accurately describe the individual property. For example a checklist for a fully furnished unit will be much more extensive than a non-furnished unit. It is in your best interest to be as specific as possible when preparing the property condition checklist.

Instructions: Tenants complete this checklist within 72 hours of moving in. Tenants and landlords (or manager) review property and completed checklist together and mutually agree on the condition of the property. Each party keeps a copy of signed checklist. This document is used again when moving out and when determining if any of the tenants deposit bond will be retained for cleaning or repairs after the move-out. BE SPECIFIC AND DETAILED when completing this document.
